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„InSwingtief“ - acoustic swing sound between gypsy-jazz and world music

Four different musicians, from various geographical and musical homegrounds, finally met and got to know each other in Würzburg.

Deeply rooted in the common musical ground of gypsy-jazz and the shared love for Django Reinhardt and Stéphane Grappelli, the band doesn't lose sleep over dogmatic genre boundaries and enhances its acoustic swing sound with references of bossa nova, klezmer, or world music in a relaxed and unacademic way.

In 2016, the band recorded its self-titled debut album followed by countless live concerts in clubs, on festival stages, at jam sessions or even at private celebrations like weddings or birthday parties.

The band's interplay and musical style are constantly evolving and the four musicians have a great appetite for more.

Now consequently „INSWINGTIEF“ are taking the next step together: „The Next Step“, the band's second full-length album, is out. And this time the ten tunes on the album are originally written, arranged, and recorded by the band itself.

The music is undoubtedly a deep bow to Django Reinhardt and Stéphane Grappelli. But all the other musical preferences and influences of the band members, like klezmer, bossa nova, or good old blues, also leave their obvious marks on the sound of the record.

„On „The Next Step“, INSWINGTIEF have once again come up with a bunch of carefully arranged tunes abundant with fresh ideas, while equally showing off the band's love for the detail, their knack for tasteful improvisations, and their broad stylistic variety.

Sabrina Damiani (Doublebass), Thomas Buffy (Violin), Stefan Degner (electric jazz guitar) and Felix Leitner (gypsy guitar) simply love what they do. And the listener can feel this joy in every note that „InSwingtief“ is playing.
